I was going out from the house at 8am and coming back after midnight every day for months... After a while it got a bit exhausting, but I was so happy to meet so many new people!

Also, the workload from university was 4-5 times more than what I was used to in the Faculty of Publizistik. We had to spend at least 10 hours per week per course, and I had 4 courses, so It felt like a full time job, which I was juggling together with the social events.
